Neighborhood Pride has strengthened community activism, built stronger neighborhood/city relationships, and empowered neighborhoods and business to work with the City to improve their community.

What Neighborhood Pride brings to your community:

Full menu of City services during Pride week including:

- Street cleaning
- Repairing trash receptacles
- Graffiti removal
- Cleaning catch basins
- Sprucing up public areas, parks, recreation centers
- Paving potholes
- Repairing broken streetlights
- Bulk trash pick-up
- Code Enforcement

Neighborhood Safety Academy and Kids Safety Academy

- Open to the community, dinner is included.

Neighborhood Pride Community Night

- Featuring information about City services and a question & answer session with City staff.

Neighborhood Pride Bicycle Safety Fest

- At a neighborhood Columbus Public Elementary School.

Neighborhood Pride Talent Search

- Students selected from neighborhood Columbus Public Middle School.

Beautiful Home Awards

- Ten homes are selected by neighborhood leaders.

Pride Partners

- Businesses have the opportunity to become more involved with their neighborhood.

Neighborhood Pride Service Center

- During Pride week, there will be opportunities to meet with City staff, a City Loan Officer, file Mobile Tool applications and more.

- Participating in the pre-Pride Bus Tour
- Distributing informational literature to all residents
- Publishing information about Neighborhood Pride in newsletters

- Nominating homes for the Neighborhood Pride Beautiful Homes Awards
- Participating in the Neighborhood Safety Academy
- Participating in the Neighborhood Pride Community Night
